

Administrative Regulation

Absences, Authorization for Pupils to Be Excused from School

A pupil shall be excused from school (not for apportionment purposes) for reasons that include a student's physical, mental, behavioral health, justifiable personal reasons, or other immediate emergencies in accordance with California Education Code 48205.

A pupil absent from school under this section shall be allowed to complete all assignments and tests missed during the absence which can be reasonably provided and, upon satisfactory completion, shall be given full credit therefor. The teacher of the class from which a pupil is absent shall determine which tests and assignments shall be reasonably equivalent to, but not necessarily identical to, the tests and assignments that the pupil missed during the absence.
