

BOARD POLICY

Organization, General Statement of

The Board of Education is the governing body of the district and derives its powers from the Constitution and statutes of the state of California. The government of the schools is vested in the Board, with the superintendent of schools as its chief executive officer to implement adopted policies, rules and regulations.

The official boundaries of the district are those set forth in the Orange County Assessor's Office and the Office of the Superintendent of Schools of Orange County.

In carrying out the duties and powers given it by the California Education Code and all laws affecting, supplementing, or amending same, the policy of the Board is to adopt and follow rules for its own government which are consistent herewith and with rules of the state Board of Education for the control of schools.

Policies, rules, and regulations may be revised, added to, or amended at a regular meeting of the Board by a majority vote of the members present.
