Administrative Regulation

Student Body Organizations, Privileges and Limitation of Funds for

In accordance with, and within the limitations set forth in the Education Code, the California Constitution, legal opinions, Board policies, and administrative regulations, the Board of Education authorizes the establishment of student body organizations and student body funds for the various schools of the district.

The student body organizations thus formed may participate in, but are not limited to:

- 1. The sale of book covers, school symbols, supply items, food (not in competition with the school meal programs), student photographs, handbooks, yearbooks, and activity cards.
- 2. Student activities, including clubs, dances, carnivals, athletic events, afterschool movies and assemblies, student newspapers, dramas, and programs.

The collection, disbursement, and control of funds shall be accomplished in accordance with procedures established by the superintendent or the designated representatives.

The respective student body organizations shall be granted the use of the school premises and properties without charge, subject to such regulations as may be established by the Board of Education.
