BOARD POLICY

Volunteer Services to the School District, Guidelines for

Members of the community who wish to offer their services toward assisting in direct classroom instruction or other forms of educational or recreational development of district students are earnestly encouraged to do so.

No compensation, gift, or gratuity of any description may be offered or accepted for such services; nor may dues or fees to conferences or clinics be offered or accepted by any individual or organization in lieu of compensation or as a gift.

Compensation for coaching may come only from the district. No coach may receive cash or any other gratuity, either directly or indirectly, from vendors, organizations, individuals, or any other source in connection with his/her services to the district's athletic program(s).

Volunteer services may include assisting classroom teachers in bringing expanded learning opportunities to students of the district, assisting athletic coaches in the performance of their duties, or assisting in other extra- or co-curricular activities such as musical or dramatic productions under the direction of a properly authorized certificated employee. In all instances, the principal shall be responsible for the selection, direction, and implementation of volunteer assistance. The principal shall maintain in the school office an accurate and current record of those individuals so utilized.

No district liability for such volunteer services is implied, authorized, or assumed.

Such volunteer services shall in no manner affect the status of existing classified positions.
