Other Governmental Agencies, Cooperation with

The Board of Education hereby declares its intent to cooperate with other local governmental and regulatory agencies for the common interest and welfare of the community in the most mutually beneficial manner. Such cooperation shall include, but is not necessarily limited to, joint use of both district and other governmental facilities whenever economical and feasible. All district taxpayers who do not benefit from proposed use are fully protected from being required to subsidize such projects or programs.
