BOARD POLICY

Community Use of School Food Services Facilities

The use of school food services facilities may be approved on a limited basis as a community service. It is not the intent of the Board of Education to compete with local restaurants.

Use of school food services facilities shall not interfere with the normal operation of the school program.

All expenses of providing the meal, including food, supplies, utilities, and salaries, shall be included in the meal charge. Meal charges shall be in addition to rental fees assessed for use of school facilities by the organization.

Kitchen use for regular PTSA meetings may be allowed if supervision and responsibility are accepted by the school principal and approved by the superintendent or the designated representatives. However, at no time other than regular PTSA meetings or school functions is a kitchen to be opened for use by other than the food service worker of the school, or a qualified person appointed in place of the food service worker.
