

Administrative Regulation

Workers' Compensation Program

Funds will be budgeted to cover the district's liability for medical and hospital expenses, loss of income, rehabilitation and any other expenses arising out of, or related to, occupational accidents, injuries, and/or illnesses sustained by employees.

For purposes of this regulation, an employee shall be defined as anyone working for wages paid by the district. Students regularly enrolled in a community classroom, shall also be considered employees and shall be provided workers' compensation benefits.

Workers' compensation insurance coverage, in accordance with laws, policies, regulations, and negotiated agreements will be coordinated by the Office of Personnel Services.

The Office of Personnel Services shall develop procedures for the efficient administration of the district's self-insured workers' compensation program.
