BOARD POLICY

Certificated Employees, Tutoring by

Teachers shall not tutor pupils enrolled in their own classes for pay nor solicit such pupils during the school year for private instruction. No teacher shall instruct for compensation during the school year any pupil who is at the time enrolled in the teacher's class or who may be removing a deficiency arising from having formerly been a pupil in the teacher's class.

No certificated staff member shall use any district facilities to give private instructions of any nature when a charge is made for such instruction, unless approval has been granted by the Board.

This does not apply to home teachers who are paid by the district.
