## Administrative Regulation

## Classified Employees, Transfer/Demotion for Medical Reasons

When an employee becomes incapacitated for the performance of any of his/her duties as determined by a medical examination, the director of classified personnel, with the approval of the Commission, may transfer him/her to a vacant position in a class of the same or lower salary level which he/she has the ability to fill, or for which he/she may be expected to acquire the necessary ability after a reasonable time.

In case of transfer to a lower level, the employee shall receive the same salary he/she is receiving in his/her former class, if possible, but the salary shall not exceed the maximum salary of the class to which the employee is transferred. The employee shall retain the anniversary date.
