BOARD POLICY

Attendance Procedures, Requirements of

The Board of Education recognizes that positive correlations exist among such factors as regular school attendance, the development of responsibility to honor commitments, and academic achievement. In addition, the Education Code of the State of California provides that individuals between the ages of six and 18 are subject to compulsory full-time education, and that the parents or guardians are obligated to compel the attendance of pupils at school.

The Board, therefore, delegates to the superintendent or the designee full authority to establish and implement effective regulations regarding attendance, including provisions of Education Code 49067(b).
