

## Administrative Regulation

Student Testing, Controls of

- A. Any test administered pursuant to the applicable Education Code provisions for the purpose of discovering conditions of “impaired mental health” may not be administered without obtaining the prior written consent of the pupil’s parent/guardian.

In addition, tests used to screen pupils for special education programs shall not be administered without prior written parental consent.

Parental consent is not required where tests are given solely as part of an academic achievement or physical performance testing program.

- B. Group testing is restricted to the measurement of achievement.

No test may be administered without permission of the superintendent or designee.
