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BOARD POLICY

Collection of Monies - Fund Raising Activities

A. Collection of Monies (K-12)

Any collection of monies/funds by teachers and/or students shall be undertaken only with prior specific approval of the superintendent or a delegated representative. Each collection of monies must be concluded with said monies deposited in an acceptable banking facility on a daily basis. No funds or monies of any description may be kept in the schools overnight.

It shall be the ultimate responsibility of each principal to ensure compliance with provisions set forth in the administrative regulations relating to proper supervision and control of fund raising activities, including those affecting student body monies.

B. Fund Raising Activities (K-12)

Fund raising projects must be justified educationally prior to the activities. No student in the Garden Grove Unified School District shall be solicited by teachers or encouraged in any manner to subscribe to the funds of, or work for, any organization not directly under the control of school authorities.

C. Soliciting Funds from Students (K-12)

Participation in fund raising drives designed to solicit funds from students, other than approved student body activities, is prohibited by the district.

D. Fund Raising at Elementary Level Only (K-6)

Under no circumstances shall elementary (K-6) students be directly involved in the sale or distribution of items or services, or in the solicitation of funds in the community.
