## BOARD POLICY

## Eligibility Requirements for Students; Extracurricular/Cocurricular Activities

It is the policy of the Board of Education that extracurricular and cocurricular activities be an integral, but supplemental, part of the education program. To promote and encourage academic excellence, all students in grades 7 through 12 shall earn and maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale in the preceding quarter, and should demonstrate satisfactory progress toward graduation, to participate and/or practice in extracurricular and cocurricular activities.

Appropriate differential standards may be applied to eligible students as specifically set forth in Education Code Section 51215.d(1).

The superintendent or designee shall determine in advance when extracurricular and cocurricular activities or programs are primarily for the student's academic and educational enrichment and therefore not subject to the eligibility requirements.

This policy shall be reviewed annually by the Board.
