

BOARD POLICY

Instructional Materials, Classroom/Library: Selection, Adoption, and Disposal of

Basic materials selected for Board adoption and subsequent use in schools shall be in accordance with California Education Code requirements.

The Board of Education recognizes that effective teaching and learning requires the selection, adoption, and use of appropriate basic and supplementary instructional materials in the classroom and library. The Board also recognizes that the active involvement of teachers, librarians, and administrators is essential to the selection and/or adoption of appropriate basic texts or learning systems, supplementary instructional materials and library books.

Every effort will be made to provide materials which present various points of view concerning problems and issues - international, national and local.

Parents, upon request, may inspect any instructional materials used as part of the educational curriculum.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent and/or designee to provide necessary regulations which specify the conduct of selection procedures, adoption calendar, and declaration of obsolescence and disposal.
