

BOARD POLICY

Channels of Communication

The Board of Education recognizes that open channels of communication are essential in fulfilling the role of a legislative body to represent all the people. The Board, therefore, expresses its genuine interest in receiving the views of community members. An open invitation to the representatives of interested community and staff organizations to be in attendance at meetings of the Board shall be one of several methods by which communication may be effectively accomplished.

To implement further this concept of open channels of communication, complete Board Agendas with supporting data (excluding personnel items, superintendent's recommendations to the board, and other items so restricted by legal provisions) will be available to interested parties at the same time copies are released to Board members. Agendas may be obtained in the Office of the Superintendent.

An agenda explaining items under consideration shall be available to those attending a Board meeting.
